Welcome to ReCreation Afterschool Art Program, the first offering of its kind in Alaska.



We have successfully combined art, recycling and community service in one program.

Art focus areas include drawing, fiber arts, papercraft, ceramics, sculpture, and collage.

Our service projects have included:

- Painting silk scarves for breast cancer patients
- Decorating sacks for Brother Francis Shelter filled with soap, lotion and shampoo
- Painting ceramic place-settings then auctioning them off to benefit Alaska's hungry
- Painting drawstring bags for kids in transition from home to foster care
- Hosting a Make It-Donate It event at the Anchorage Senior Center

We believe that children naturally want to serve others and just need an outlet. When given the chance, our students have proven time and again that they will step up and help others in need using their own creative talents.

Whenever possible, we use recycled or donated art materials in our work.

Most elementary school students in Anchorage receive about 2 hours a month of formal art education. Some classroom teachers integrate art into their lessons, but not all of them have the time or resources to allow children to fully explore their creativity.

At ReCreation, we offer art enrichment in a safe setting where children can spend extended time doing art, thus deepening their understanding of blending technique, creativity and their own style into every project they do.

We raise awareness of beauty in every day life and encourage children to work in a group setting to come up with projects and community service ideas. Our students are also allowed to work individually to develop an artistic style, philosophy and goals for themselves as artists.

Program fee is \$350 per month per child for after-school programming five days a week. Part-time enrollment is available, but special terms apply. Two days a week is \$165 per month and three days a week is \$250 per month. We accept Day Care Assistance of all kinds— Muni, State, and Native Corporation.
